

First call our office to see if your problem needs to be seen on the same day or can be scheduled at a later time. When Conifer Medical Center is unavailable you must visit an Urgent Care Center for NON-LIFE THREATENING emergencies. ER visits should be for LIFE THREATENING emergencies only. ER visits can leave you with very large copays and deductibles.

Be aware that any freestanding ER will charge the same as an ER and you may end up with a very expensive bill.

Urgent care centers are equipped to handle non-life threatening situations such as:

- Mild to moderate allergic reactions
- X rays
- Flu, cough, sore throat and cold
- Sprains, strains and broken bones
- Fever
- Bumps, cuts and scrapes
- Nausea, vomiting and diarrhea
- Stitches
- Mild to moderate headaches
- Minor burns
- Urinary tract infections
- Eye swelling, irritation, redness or pain
- Mild asthma
- Rashes
